Every step in each sector assurance chain must be a current member of the required third-party accreditation scheme/s

Storage	Member of a recognised storage scheme (third party storing of combinable crops off-farm)	No	TASCC
Crops or Sugar Beet Processor	Grain milled into product which is then packed and labelled for sale to retailers/food service, further processing	Yes	BRCGS Food Safety Standard or BRCGS Start! Intermediate level or SALSA Food Standard or

Wholesaler	Takes delivery of Red Tractor claimed product and does not process the product in an open environment. Product arrives and leaves in the same state	Yes	N/A unless where tempering, date coding and/or sleeving: BRCGS Storage & Distribution (RT Wholesaler Licence Agreement under derogation) All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee
Trader	Products sourced from Red Tractor licensed businesses. Does not take physical ownership/handle the product/s, arranges distribution and storage	Yes	N/A All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee
Food Service	Purchases and promotes Red Tractor crop based product/s using a Red Tractor Claim on menus, websites etc.	Yes	N/A All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee. The Red Tractor Claim must be specific to the Red Tractor product being promoted and not misleading to the consumer in any way
