



Red Tractor Licensing Eligibility Criteria

Every step in each sector assurance chain must be a current member of the required third-party accreditation scheme/s

Abattoir & Cutting plant	Takes in live birds, kills, cuts and packs poultry products	Yes	Red Tractor Assurance for Meat and Poultry Processing Scheme (with Certification scope for slaughter and cutting of chicken/turkey/duck; must have RTMPP for slaughter but can have BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food for cutting/packing instead of RTMPP Food Safety module). For Enhanced Welfare Chicken, site must be RTMPP and certain slaughter conditions apply
Cutting Plant	Bought-in poultry to further process/cut/pack	Yes	Red Tractor Assurance for Meat and Poultry Processing Scheme or BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food
Catering Butchers	Bought-in poultry/cuts to further prepare/cut/pack	Yes	Red Tractor Assurance for Meat and Poultry Processing Scheme or BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food



Further Processing (Excludes Cooking)	Further processing includes mincing and dicing and where poultry is the main ingredient	Yes	Red Tractor Assurance for Meat and Poultry Processing Scheme or BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food
Cooking	Cooking of poultry products to pack for sale to retailers and food service	Yes	BRCGS Food Safety Standard or FSSC 22000 or IFS Food
Wholesaler	Takes delivery of Red Tractor claimed product and does not process the product in an open environment. Product arrives and leaves in the same state	Yes	N/A unless where tempering, date coding and/or sleeving: BRCGS Storage & Distribution (Red Tractor Wholesaler Licence Agreement under derogation) All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee
Trader	Products sourced from Red Tractor licensed businesses. Does not take physical ownership/handle the product/s, arranges distribution and storage	Yes	N/A All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee



Food Service	Purchases and promotes Red Tractor poultry and/or poultry products using the Red Tractor Claim on menus, websites etc.	Yes	N/A All Red Tractor products sourced and sold with a Red Tractor Claim have been supplied by a Red Tractor licensee. The Red Tractor Claim must be specific to the Red Tractor product being promoted and not misleading to the consumer in any way
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
